

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DR. HARVEY AWARD - NOMINATION FORM



The Award is named for Dr. Edward Harvey, who first saw the importance of the recognition of historic buildings by creating self-made plaques with a brief history of the property. Dr. Harvey also lobbied the Clatsop County Commissioners to establish a Historic Advisory Committee, of which he served as a chairman for many years.

Since 1987, the Dr. Harvey Award is presented each year to recognize a property owner who has completed exterior restoration or beautification of a structure, which exemplifies the historical attributes or the architectural heritage of Astoria. To qualify, the work must have been *completed* within the last two years.

Nominations may include residential, commercial, public, and other types of buildings. Priority will be given to buildings within the City, which are listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the City of Astoria Historic Landmark list, and/or buildings whose owners have consulted the Historic Landmarks Commission in advance of carrying out the project.

The recipients will be determined by the Historic Landmarks Commission and the awards will be presented by the Mayor to celebrate National Historic Preservation Month in May.
